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May 29th, 2020 - this author is advocating that black play the pribyl 1 e4 d6 2 d4 nf6 3 nc3 c6 the wade defense 1 d4 d6 2 nf3 bg4 in the case where white clamps down on e5 and against 1 d4 amp 2 c4 he suggests 1 d4 d6 2 c4 e5 which doesn't have a name but is quite effective

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touch move rule

June 5th, 2020 - the touch move rule in chess specifies that if a player deliberately touches a piece on the board when it is their turn to move then they must move or capture that piece if it is legal to do so if it is the player s piece that was touched it must be moved if they have a legal move if the opponent s piece was touched it must be captured if it can be captured with a legal move

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
